Changes to the Standard Risk Measure (SRM)

The Standard Risk Measure is a way of describing the level of risk of different investment options (with 1 being the lowest and 7 the highest) and is based on an estimate of the number of negative annual returns over any 20-year period. It doesn't consider all forms of investment risk. You should ensure you're comfortable with the risks and potential losses associated with the investment options you choose to invest in.

Effective from 31 July 2021, the Standard Risk Measure for Investment options have changed. The investment options impacted are summarised below:
